

Forever In My Heart Friday Scholarship In Honor of Myesha Reed 2018 Scholarship Program

Myesha Reed was a graduate of Northeast Magnet High School and aspired of becoming a neonatal or obstetrics nurse. Unfortunately, she tragically passed away at the early age of 18 after complications from surgery. The **Forever In My Heart Friday Scholarship** was created by Crystal Wiley, her mother, in hopes that a graduating senior from Northeast Magnet High School achieve the same hopes and dreams her daughter did not get to fulfill. A \$1000 scholarship will be awarded to a senior aspiring to go into the nursing field.

One scholarship will be awarded per year. Program Guidelines & Priorities:

- Applicants must be a graduating senior with a record of non-school sponsored volunteerism in the community and participation in extracurricular school activities.
- Applicants must plan to attend a two (2)-year community college, a four (4)-year college or university, or a Technical College.
- Scholarship funds will be paid during the month of August 2019—directly to the
 college, not the student. The scholarship funds will be issued to the college or university
 upon receiving a certificate of enrollment for the fall semester, which includes the
 Student ID number and Financial Aid Office address.
- Applicants must have the endorsement of their Guidance Counselor on their application attesting they are qualified for this scholarship program.
- Applications must be received no later than **February 17**, **2019**. Applications received after that date will not be accepted.

The applications and essays will be reviewed, and a recipient will be selected by the Forever In My Heart Friday Scholarship Committee. The scholarship will be awarded **March 17, 2019.** A formal award letter will be sent to the scholarship winner.
